PENALTY - NON EXHIBITION OF DOGS

Your attention is drawn to Special Regulation 10, that provide for a fine when an entry is not Exhibited, except in certain circumstances.

These Regulations will be enforced at the 2024 Show.

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

Your attention is drawn to Special Regulation 27. Despite General Regulation 130(c), a Treatment Notification Form must be submitted at the Dog Office by 8.30am on the day of judging, except for Agility Exhibits which is required by 8am on the day of judging.

The RAS reserves the right to close entries before the official closing Day of Entry and to restrict the number of Exhibits in any breed or Class of breed if in the opinion of the Domestic Animals Committee it would be unsafe to accommodate further Exhibits.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

APPLICATIONS FOR ENTRY	It is recommended that a printed copy of your online Application for Entry Confirmation or a photocopy of your Application for Entry is kept for your records.
EXHIBITOR ENQUIRIES	If you require additional Applications for Entry or further information about the Dog Section, please call (02) 9704 1007 or email: domesticanimals@rasnsw.com.au
CONDITIONS OF ENTRY	Exhibitors must adhere to the Conditions of Entry to Sydney Showground located at www.rasnsw.com.au , the RAS General Regulations and the Special Sydney Royal Dog Regulations in this Schedule (the "Regulations"), as they are bound by these terms.
	A condition of entering Competitions is strict adherence to the Regulations. Accordingly, Applications for Entry in the name of deceased Person(s) are not eligible for entry.
	The Application for Entry and the Regulations shall constitute the whole agreement upon which entries are submitted and the Exhibitor agrees that all representations and statements not appearing on the Application for Entry or in the Regulations are excluded.
	The Exhibitor certifies that each animal Exhibited by them or by their child/children/guardian is duly registered and either their property absolutely or is under their absolute care and control. The Exhibitor holds the RAS exempt from any liability in the event of any loss or damage from any cause whatsoever.
	The RAS has the power to evict any Exhibitor from the Showground in the event of a breach of the Conditions of Entry to Sydney Showground, RAS General Regulations and/or the 2024 ADVANCE™ Sydney Royal Dog Show Schedule.
WITHDRAWALS	A refund of Entry Fees shall not be made unless a notification of withdrawal is received by the RAS before the Closing Day of Entry. To withdraw an Exhibit in part or in full, Exhibitors must log into their online Competition entry system account and select the Classes they wish to withdraw for each Exhibit and complete the withdrawal process.
INCORRECT AND INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS FOR ENTRY	A Correction Fee of up to \$50 may be charged by the RAS, at its discretion, for each Application for Entry which is incorrect or incomplete. If an Application for Entry is not rectified in accordance with RAS' requirements, the entry may not be accepted by the RAS.
EXHIBIT CONFIRMATION ADVICE (BENCHSLIP) AND DASHBOARD SLIPS	Please note that an Exhibit Confirmation Advice (Benchslip) is required for access to the Showground. A Dashboard Slip will also be issued to Exhibitors with the Authorised Contact Person's mobile number printed on the slip. A Dashboard Slip must be displayed on the dashboard of each vehicle at all times while on the Showground.
BEST OF BREED, BEST NEUTER OF BREED AND BEST PUPPY OF BREED	Best of Breed, Best Neuter of Breed and Best Puppy of Breed will be judged daily. Winners will be required to return for Group judging on Monday 1 April 2024.
BEST PUPPY OF THE DAY (PER GROUP)	Best Puppy of Breed will be judged daily. Best Puppy of the Day (Per Group) will be selected from one Best Puppy of Breed from each Group every day at the conclusion of judging each day. The daily winners will be required to return for final Best Puppy in Show judging on Monday 1 April 2024.
BEST BABY PUPPY OF THE DAY	All Best Baby Puppies of the Breed will compete for Best Baby Puppy of the Day at the conclusion of breed judging each day. The daily winner will be required to return for final Best Baby Puppy in Show judging on Monday 1 April 2024.
BREEDERS GROUP OF THE DAY	All Breeders Groups will be judged daily at the conclusion of their breed judging the afternoon session. The Ring will be advised each morning. Best Breeders Group of the Day will be judged and winners will be required to return for Breeders Group in Show judging on Monday 1 April 2024.
OWNER-BREEDER-HANDLER EXHIBIT OF THE DAY	All Owner-Breeder-Handler Class will be judged daily. The Best Owner Breeder Handler Exhibit will be selected from one Best Owner-Breeder-Handler across all groups every day at the conclusion of judging each day. The daily winners will be required to return for final Best Owner-Breeder-Handler in Show judging on Monday 1 April 2024
HANDLER COMPETITION	First place Exhibits of Classes 60 - 64 to be judged on Saturday 23 March 2024 and will be required to return for General Specials on Monday 1 April 2024.
ELIMINATIONS	A Puppy Exhibit which wins Best Exhibit in Group but is not awarded Best Puppy in Show shall be eliminated from competing for the Best Exhibit in Show and Runner Up to Best Exhibit in Show Awards. The Puppy will still parade with the eligible Best Exhibit in Show Exhibits.

	 Specialist Breed Clubs and Sporting Clubs have an ideal opportunity to promote themselves to one of the largest audiences in NSW at the 2024 ADVANCE™ Sydney Royal Dog Show. The Pavilion will be open to the public from 9am until 5pm. All Clubs must provide their own display materials. EXHIBITOR DETAILS	When completing an Application for Entry the Exhibitor must provide the Exhibitor's full name on the application. An Exhibitor is the Registered Owner/s of the dog as it is recorded with the Recognised Controlling Body. This name will appear in RAS Publications and be published on website results.
JUDGES ALLOCATION	The RAS reserves the right at all times at its absolute discretion without assigning any reason to: (a) substitute a Judge when necessary; (b) re-allocate judging days for a particular breed. (c) if entry numbers require an extra Judge, appoint an additional Judge if necessary.
RING STEWARDS & SPONSORS	Ring Stewards and employees of major Sponsors involved with the Dog Section will not be permitted to handle Exhibits during the Show. Exhibits owned or co-owned by Ring Stewards or employees of major Sponsors involved with the Dog Section will not be permitted to Exhibit at the Show.
RINGS & DAILY JUDGING TIMETABLE ALLOCATION	Please note that judging will not commence before 8:30am Conformation days and on General Specials Day. Agility will commence at 8am. No vetting is required for Agility, Obedience or Conformation. Morning and afternoon judging times will be on display on the glass doors beside the Dog Administration Office each day.
ENTRY FEES AND RAS MEMBERSHIP DISCOUNT	In order for Exhibitors to claim the RAS Member discount on Entry Fees for this Competition, Membership subscriptions must be paid and accepted by the RAS before entering this Competition, and details must be provided on your Application for Entry prior to submitting to the RAS. No adjustments will be provided after the Application for Entry has been submitted. The Membership Name must be: (i) where the Exhibitor is a single Person, the Exhibitor Name; (ii) where the Exhibitor is more than one Person or a partnership, one of the Persons forming that partnership; or (iii) where the Exhibitor is a firm or company, the Authorised Contact Person/Representative of that firm or company. Members who are not financial at the time of submitting their Entry Fees will not be eligible for the entry discount.

	Entry Fee reductions are dependent upon Class(es) being entered. Non-member Entry Fees apply for Exhibitors where they are not financial members of the RAS. Applicants acknowledge that a valid RAS membership number must be provided at the time of submitting their application in order to receive the applicable discount.

PRIZES AND GST

The Australian Taxation Office has deemed that GST is payable on prizes if an Exhibitor is registered for GST and enters an Exhibit as part of a business enterprise.

The information an Exhibitor provides on the Application for Entry determines whether GST is applicable.

Any prize stated in this Schedule does not include GST.

GST will not apply:

- a. if an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as a hobby or private recreational pursuit; or
- b. if an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as part of a business enterprise, the Exhibitor has an ABN, but the Exhibitor is NOT REGISTERED for GST.
- c. if an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as part of a business enterprise the Exhibitor is not entitled to an ABN as the business or enterprise is not operating in Australia.

GST will apply:

d. if an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as part of a business enterprise, the Exhibitor has an ABN, and the Exhibitor is REGISTERED for GST.

Where GST applies, the RAS will pay the prize money quoted in this Schedule plus 10% GST. The RAS will issue a recipient created tax invoice.

WARNING: The Exhibitor must complete the **Tax Details** on the Application for Entry. Failure to do so will result in the RAS deducting 47% of the successful Exhibitor's prize money as Pay As You Go Tax (PAYG). The RAS recommends that the Exhibitor seeks professional advice before completing the Tax Details.

Prize money won during the Sydney Royal Easter Show will be paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) to the account details provided at the time of Entry. If the bank details are incomplete or incorrect the RAS will take all reasonable efforts to contact prize winners to confirm payment details.

The RAS seek to finalise all prize money payments by the end of June. Queries regarding unpaid prize money can be addressed to the Service Centre by email at competitions@rasnsw.com.au. Following all reasonable efforts to contact the prize winner, any prize money not claimed by 1

December, is deemed forfeited by the Exhibitor.

COMPUTATION OF AGE OF DOGS

The age of the dog for the purpose of a Show shall be calculated from the date of birth as recorded with a Recognised Controlling Body as at the first day of the Show, being Friday 22 March 2024.

ELIGIBILITY OF ENTRY CONFORMATION & SWEEPSTAKES

- Baby Puppy Class is confined to any dog or bitch 3 months of age and under 6 months of age. For dogs born after 22 Sep 2023 and on or before 22 Dec 2023.
- **Puppy Class** is confined to any dog or bitch 6 months and under 12 months of age. For dogs born after 22 Mar 2023 and on or before 22 Sep 2023.
- Junior Class is confined to any dog or bitch 9 months and under 18 months of age. For dogs born after 22 Sep 2022 and on or before 22 Jun 2023.
- Intermediate Class is confined to any dog or bitch 18 months and under 36 months of age. For dogs born after 22 Mar 2021 and on or before 22 Sep 2022.
- Australian Bred Class is confined to any dog or bitch 6 months of age and over whelped in Australia. For dogs born on or before 22 Sep 2023.
- Open Class is confined to any dog or bitch 6 months of age and over. For dogs born on or before 22 Sep 2023.
- Veterans 7 to under 10 years is confined to any dog or bitch 7 years of age and under 10 years. For dogs or bitches born after 22 Mar 2014 and on or before 22 Mar 2017.
- Veterans 10 years and over is confined to any dog or bitch 10 years of age and over. For dogs and bitches born on or before 22 Mar 2014.
- Neuter Class is confined to any neutered dog or bitch 6 months of age and over. For dogs
 or bitches born on or before 22 Sep 2023.
- Champion Sweepstakes confined to any dog or bitch that have attained the title of Australian Champion or Champion in another country.
- Supreme Champion Sweepstakes confined to any dog or bitch that have attained the title
 of Supreme Champion.

Owner-Breeder-Handler Classis confined to any dog or bitch, 6 months of age and over, that is owned by the same person or persons that bred the dog or bitch and entered in a normal Conformation class. The dog must be handled by the breeder (or co breeder if listed on the prefix)

ELIGIBILITY OF ENTRY CONFORMATION & SWEEPSTAKES cont.

• Breeders Group Class is confined to:

Class.

- (a) four (4) dogs and or bitches of the same breed;
- (b) confined to a dog or bitch 6 months of age and over
- (c) bred under the same Kennel Prefix but can be registered to different Exhibitors;(d) all dogs entered as part of a Breeders Group must also be entered in a Conformation
- (e) Exhibits entered on breed day, must remain the same Exhibits if returning for General Specials
- (f) Exhibits entered in Breeders Group Classes must be entered under the Breeders name. Exhibitors are encouraged to wear clothing that complements the dogs and each other. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify Exhibitors who are not deemed to be appropriately dressed from the Breeders Group.
- A Recognised Controlling Body must have officially accepted all dogs and such registration must be acceptable to Dogs NSW.
- 2. Bitches in oestrum are eligible to compete in Conformation Classes.
- 3. Dogs and Bitches entered in Champion Sweepstakes or Supreme Champion Sweepstakes must have attained the appropriate title at time of entry.
- The RAS reserves the right to close entries before closing Day of Entry if in the opinion of
 the Committee it would be unsafe to attempt to accommodate further Exhibits and to
 restrict the number of Exhibits in any breed or Class of breed. For 2024, there may be a
 restriction on the total number of entries. Early entry is strongly recommended to avoid
 missing out.

ELIGIBILITY OF ENTRY - OBEDIENCE, RALLY, AGILITY AND HANDLER

OBEDIENCE

- (a) Classes are defined as Utility Dog Excellent (UDX), Utility Dog (UD), Open (CDX), Novice (CD), Community Companion Dog (CCD).
 - Community Companion Dog: for dogs and bitches with a minimum of two qualifications towards the Title of Community Companion Dog (CCD) prior to the closing date of entry and must not have been awarded the title of Community Companion Dog (CCD) prior to the date of the trial
 - Novice Class: for dogs and bitches with a minimum of one qualification that must not have been awarded the title of Companion Dog (CD) prior to the closing day of entry
 - Open Class: for dogs and bitches which have qualified for the title of 'Companion Dog' (CD) in Novice Class.
 - **Utility Class:** for dogs and bitches which have qualified for the title of 'Companion Dog Excellent' (CDX) in Open Class.
 - **Utility Dog Excellent Class**: for dogs and bitches which have qualified for the title of 'Utility Dog' (UD) in Utility Class. Note: there are NO qualifying scores required.
 - **Dual Title Class**: for dogs and bitches 12 months of age and over and have gained a Champion title in Conformation and gained a title in a performance discipline.
- (b) Bitches in oestrum are **not** eligible to compete.
- (c) For all Awards and placings, a qualifying score will take precedence over a non-qualifying score.
- (d) A non-qualifying score shall not in itself necessarily constitute the grounds to order removal, and dogs will generally be given the opportunity to complete the trial exercises. If however, during Competition in the opinion of the Judge, the Handler is using the ring for training they will be directed to leave the ring.
- (e) Dogs must be 6 months of age or over to be entered in an Obedience Class. (or 12 months of age to enter the Dual Title Class)

RALLY

- (f) Classes are defined as Rally Novice, Rally Advance, Rally Excellent and Rally Master
 - Rally Novice Class: for dogs and bitches, six months of age or over which are not eligible for the title of Rally Novice (RN). Dogs negotiate a course having between 10 and 15 signs (not including the start and finish) and work on lead during the test. Earning the title of RN requires 3 qualifying scores of at least 75 points out of 100 under at least 2 judges. Under no circumstance except where an application for a RN Title has been rejected on a technicality, shall a dog which has competed in a Rally Advanced A class be eligible to compete in the Rally Novice class.
 - Rally Advance Class: for dogs and bitches, six months of age or over. This class shall
 be for dogs that have qualified for the Rally Novice (RN) Title. Dogs negotiate a
 course having between 12 and 17 signs (not including the start and finish), and has
 to include 1 jump and work is off lead during the test. Earning the title of RA
 requires 3 qualifying scores of at least 80 points out of 100 under at least 2 judges

ELIGIBILITY OF ENTRY - OBEDIENCE, AGILITY AND HANDLER cont

- Rally Excellent Class: for dogs and bitches, six months of age or over. Dogs negotiate a course having between 15 and 20 signs (not including the start and finish), and has to include 2 jumps and work is off lead during the test. Earning the title of RE requires 3 qualifying scores of at least 80 points out of 100 under at least 2 judges. This class shall be for dogs that have qualified for the Rally Advanced (RA) title.
- Rally Master Class: for dogs and bitches, six months of age or over. This class shall be dogs that have qualified for the Rally excellent title (R.E.) dogs negotiate a course having between 18 and 24 signs. Earning the title of RE requires 3 qualifying scores of at least 80 points out of 100 under at least 2 judges. All exercises are judged off lead and there will be no jumps in this class.
- (g) Bitches in oestrum are **not** eligible to compete.
- (h) For all Awards and placings, a qualifying score will take precedence over a nonqualifying score.
- (i) If a team receives a non-qualifying score on a course, judging will cease immediately and no retries will be allowed. A dog that has been non-qualified for fouling the ring shall immediately be excused. A Judge who has non-qualified a Handler may excuse the team immediately from the course at the point at which they have non-qualified.

AGILITY

Agility is a dog competition open to all dogs.

The aim of this competition is for a Handler to direct their dog around a course of different obstacles to assess and enhance the ability of the dog and Handler to work as a team.

Any person making an entry in an Agility Trial does so at their own risk and the RAS of NSW, Dogs NSW, Dogs Australia, Judge, Steward or official shall not be responsible for any injury or damage to any dog.

Eligibility of Entry

 Agility Trials are open to dogs or bitches registered with a recognised Controlling body, 18 months of age or over.

b. Classes

Classes are defined as Novice, Excellent and Master and any other class that the Dogs Australia or RAS determines.

The following Class description applies to Agility, Jumping and Games

- 1. NOVICE CLASS: For dogs or bitches that are not eligible for the Novice title.
- 2. EXCELLENT CLASS: For dogs or bitches that have qualified and applied for the Novice title and are not eligible for the Excellent title.
- MASTER CLASS: For dogs or bitches that have qualified and applied for the Excellent title or Master title.

c. Not for Competition

Not for Competition (NFC) runs will NOT be permitted during this trial.

d. **Qualifications**

Qualifications up to and including the date of closing of entry, shall count as eligibility to compete in any Class. At the discretion of the RAS of NSW and or Chief Steward, a competitor who completes the necessary passes to a title and has applied for that title, after the closing of entry, may request and be transferred to the next higher class.

e. **Height**

Dogs must be entered into one of the following height categories.

- 200 Up to and including 270 mm
- 300 271 mm up to and including 365 mm
- 400 366 mm up to and including 455 mm
- 500 456 mm up to and including 545 mm
- 600 546 mm and over
- Dogs are permitted to compete in the category immediately above their measured height, but must not compete in the height category below their officially measured height
- The Judge may check at random the height of the dog by requesting to sight the dog's Official Height Card and/or utilize a Dogs Australia approved measuring device on a hard level surface.
- f. Bitches in oestrum are not eligible to compete
- g. The Judge may order the removal and disqualification from all competitions on the day any dog that attacks and must lodge a report with a recognised Controlling body. The Judge may order removal from competition of any dog which does not obey its Handler, any Handler who interferes wilfully with any competitor or a competitor's dog or whose behaviour is objectionable and must exclude from competition any dog which the Judge considers unfit to compete.
- Any Handler who does not answer the Ring Steward's third call may be marked 'absent'.

Entering and Exiting the Ring ELIGIBILITY OF ENTRY - OBEDIENCE, AGILITY AND HANDLER cont On the Steward's call of the dog's catalogue number, the Handler will enter the ring via the entry point, with the dog on lead either carried or walked and follow the Steward's and/or Judge's instructions. The lead and harness or head collar must be A Handler may enter the ring (with the dog on lead) whilst the previous dog is completing its run. 2. The only items that a dog can wear whilst running the course are: A fixed, flat collar with no fixtures or tags etc. dangling from the collar, with the exception of D or O rings which form part of the collar II. Ribbons or bands to keep the hair away from the face. A dog shall not be physically touched after the Judge has indicated that they may go. The lead shall not be considered a training aid. A dog may interact or play with their lead inside the ring provided it is not disruptive to other dogsOn completion of the dog's run, the Handler will exit the ring via the exit point with the dog on lead. Dogs are permitted to be carried out of the ring providing the lead is attached to the collar. m. Course inspection Before judging commences, Handlers may familiarise themselves with the course without their dogs. Only Handlers entered in the class are allowed to walk the course, except with the express permission of the Judge. Judges may split the number of Handlers, to eliminate large numbers on course inspection. No dogs are permitted in the ring prior to the commencement of judging. Any objection by a competitor to the equipment or layout of the course must be lodged with the Judge in the first instance. If an agreement cannot be achieved then the objection may be lodged with the Chief Steward. Any objections must be lodged prior to judging. Rudeness or aggression towards any stewards will not be tolerated and competitors may be disqualified if they are found to be rude or aggressive to stewards. Should competitors have an issue with a steward, this should be taken up with the Chief **HANDLER** (a) Bitches in oestrum are not eligible to be paraded before the Judge. (b) Dogs do not need to have been entered in a Conformation Class. (c) Dogs must be over 12 months of age. (d) Dogs must be registered with Dogs Australia. **TRANSFERS** In Obedience, Rally and Agility: (a) Any animal which by judging day has become ineligible for a Class in which it is entered shall not compete in such Class. (b) If the Committee deems suitable, a transfer to another class, must be submitted in writing by the Exhibitor, no more than 7 days prior to their judging date. (c) The Committee reserves the right if it so chooses, to transfer an animal from a Class in which it has been entered but for which on judging day it is ineligible to compete, to a Class for which it is or has become, eligible to compete. **CONDITIONS (Handler Classes)** The Judge shall consider: (a) The ability of the Handler to control the Exhibit. The Award to go to the Handler who, in the opinion of the Judge, presents his/her Exhibit will in the most skilled fashion, and in accordance with these Regulations. The quality of the Exhibit not to be taken into account. The Judge shall

not require the Handler to exchange Exhibits in the ring.

IMPORTED DOGS	An imported dog will qualify for entry if it has:
	 (a) the necessary qualifications gained in Australia or outside Australia, or partly in Australia or outside Australia; and (b) been registered with an overseas canine controlling body recognised by the RAS and is under three (3) months since its arrival in Australia. After three (3) months the imported Exhibit's registration must be transferred to a resident of Australia who is a financial member of a Recognised Controlling Body in order to qualify for entry. In the event of any inconsistency concerning imported dogs rules, the rules of the Australian National Kennel Council will prevail. Entries for newly imported dogs will be accepted provided the Exhibitor contacts the Domestic Animals Coordinator on telephone (02) 9704 1007 or email domesticanimals@rasnsw.com.au for an Application for Entry prior to Wednesday 7 February 2024.
RESTRICTION OF ENTRIES	(a) A dog may not be entered in more than one Breed/Conformation Class.(b) An entry may not be transferred from one Class to another except at the direction of the Committee.

MR SHAWN J. NICHOLS (CANADA) Conformation

While Shawn began judging in 2012, his involvement with purebred dogs goes right back to the early 1980's when he attended his first show.

As a professional handler of all breeds, Shawn has also bred and shown Wire Fox Terriers, and Scottish Terriers, as well as Toy and Miniature Poodles under the Typecast prefix, and Whippets under Brushwood. His commitment to the sport has also allowed him the opportunity of working with professional handlers including Mark and Sally George, Tim Brazier, Mark Shanoff and Carol Graham.

Shawn has served on the board of several clubs, is the Chairman of the Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club and in 2007 purchased and assumed responsibility for the 'Terrier Type' magazine.

Juha has been involved with pedigree dogs since he was a child, breeding his first Löwchen litter in 1983 and his first Lhasa Apso litter two years later.

His passion for dogs saw him establish the renowned Chic Choix Kennels in Finland, specialising in Lhasa Apsos. He has also bred Irish Setters, Deerhounds and King Charles Spaniels with more than 650 Champions around the world, over 160 Best in Group 1st winners and some 70 All Breed Best in Show winners.

Chic Choix has bred a record of more than 50 World Winners and bred or owned BIG/BIS winners in Bichon Frises, Maltese, Norrbottenspets, Greyhounds, Azawakhs, Alaskan Malamutes, Sealyham Terriers and

Bracco Italianos. Many champions have also been named among the Kennel's Tibetan Spaniels, Griffons, Smooth Fox Terriers, Australian Silky Terriers and Yorkshire Terriers.

As a published author, Juha has written two books on pedigree dogs along with countless magazine articles.

Juha has served as the President of the Finnish Dog Breeders Association and became a Judge in 2002, officiating at shows across the world. His lives by the motto 'joie de vivre' with hobbies including photography, travelling, and spending time in nature.

SPECIAL DOG REGULATIONS

1. INTERPRETATION OF REGULATIONS

- (a) The RAS General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show. These Special Dog Regulations apply to this Section only. Unless expressly stated in the General Regulations, if there is any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these Special Dog Regulations, the Special Dog Regulations prevail. Copies of all Regulations are available from the Administration office at the Showground. General Regulations are available at www.rasnsw.com.au.
- (b) Championship Show, Agility, Obedience, Sweepstakes and Handler Competitions, are held under the Rules and Regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society of NSW and Dogs NSW.
- (c) In the event of any conflict between the regulations, dispute or difference concerning the meaning of the Regulations or the Application for Entry details, the decision of the Committee shall be final and binding.

2. DEFINITIONS

In these Regulations, unless there be something in the subject or context inconsistent therewith:

Championship Show means a Recognised Show which has been granted such title by Dogs NSW or by a Recognised Controlling Body and at which Challenge Certificates shall be or have been awarded by authority of Dogs NSW or of a Recognised Controlling Body to Competitors of a breed of dog judged thereat.

 $\begin{tabular}{ll} \textbf{Committee} & means the Domestic Animals Committee of the RAS \\ \end{tabular}$

Exhibit used as a noun shall, where the context reasonably permits, be deemed to refer to anything in any Class of the Show

Handler means the Person responsible for the display of an Exhibit in the judging enclosure or responsible for the care of an Exhibit in the Pavilion.

Junior Handler means a minor who is over the age of 7 years and under the age of 19 years and competes in a Competition. **Person** words importing "Person" include a firm, partnership, company or corporation.

Recognised Controlling Body means Dogs NSW; Dogs Victoria; Canine Control Council Queensland; South Australian Canine Association Inc.; Canine Association of Western Australia Inc.; Tasmanian Canine Association; Australian Capital Territory Canine Association Inc.; Northern Australian Canine Association.

Recognised Show, Recognised Obedience Trial and Recognised Agility Trial means a Show or Obedience Trial conducted by the RAS or by Dogs NSW or a Show or Obedience Trial approved as a Recognised Show or a Recognised Obedience Trial by Dogs NSW or by the RAS.

Unrecognised Show or **Unrecognised Obedience Trial** shall have the converse meaning.

Show used as a noun includes any function at which dogs compete and at which prizes are awarded.

RAS means Royal Agricultural Society of NSW.

Veterinary Surgeon means the Veterinary Surgeon appointed by the Committee and includes his/her deputy.

In these Regulations words shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Regulations of Dogs NSW.

3. WARRANTY

Every Exhibitor warrants that he/she is the Owner of every animal brought by him/her or by his/her authority onto the Showground.

4. INDEMNITY

Exhibitors agree to be responsible for their Exhibits at all times, any acts and omissions on the part of a Person given responsibility by an Exhibitor, acts as an agent of the Exhibitor, and the Persons acts and omissions will be deemed those of the Exhibitor. The Exhibitor agrees to indemnify the RAS, from any loss or injury to or caused by the Exhibit. The full indemnity and release is contained in the General Regulations.

5. VETTING

(a) All puppies must be over 3 months of age at the first day of the Show, 22 March 2024 and be fully vaccinated, with vaccinations carried out no less than 14 days prior to the Show.

6. SICK OR DISEASED ANIMALS

- (a) The RAS Veterinary Surgeon, will decide whether a dog or puppy is:
 - (i) sick;
 - (ii) injured;
 - (iii) diseased;
 - (iv) likely to be affected with a contagious or infectious disease due to known, or reasonably suspected, of contact with contagious or infectious disease within 30 days or the relevant incubation period, whichever is the shorter, prior to the date upon which the relevant Exhibit was brought on to the Showground; or
 - (v) showing any signs of any surgical or other artificial interference which is calculated to deceive or is capable of deceiving spectators.
- (b) In such cases the entry may be cancelled or the Exhibit disqualified and the Exhibitor agrees to follow the directions of the RAS in relation to either removing the animal from the Showground or quarantining the animal.
- (c) If the Exhibitor breaches this regulation, the Exhibitor agrees to be:
 - responsible for all costs associated with the RAS organising the removal and appropriate kennelling for the animal; and
 - (ii) subject to a Disciplinary Hearing for the breach.

7. DOGS NOT PHYSICALLY ENTIRE

- (a) A dog six months of age or over shall not be accepted as physically Entire unless both testicles have descended and are in the scrotum.
- (b) If a Judge forms the opinion that an Exhibit is not Entire, he shall
 - (i) so inform the Exhibitor;
 - (ii) excuse the Exhibit from the ring;
 - (iii) forthwith, so inform the Chief Steward

8. PARADES

- (a) An Exhibit must be paraded from time to time as directed by the RAS. Any Exhibitor who fails to parade his Exhibit when called upon shall forfeit all prizes and prize money.
- (b) An animal will not be eligible to parade or to compete in a Class by reason only of the RAS' acceptance of its entry and/or of its inclusion in the RAS' printed Catalogue.

9. COMMITTEE'S RIGHT TO CANCEL AN ENTRY

In order to effectively run competitions, entries may have to be cancelled from time to time. The Committee has the right to cancel an Entry (even after Acceptance) if deemed appropriate, without providing their reasons to the Exhibitor. Acting reasonably, Entry Fees will be refunded at the Committee's discretion.

10. PENALTY - NON EXHIBITION OF DOGS

- (a) An Exhibitor making an entry will be subject to a fine of \$50 for each entry not Exhibited, unless a notification under the hand of the Exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the RAS prior to commencement of judging the Class in which the Exhibit is entered that such non-Exhibition is caused either by:
 - (i) the death of the animal or animals,
 - (ii) contagious or infectious disease confirmed by a Veterinary Certificate, or
 - (iii) any other reasonable cause acceptable to the Committee.
- (b) Non-payment of the fine in (a) will prevent the Person making the entry from Exhibiting at future Exhibitions of the RAS.

Note: Regulation 10(a) will be applied to Best of Breed Exhibits that do not return on General Specials Day Monday 1 April 2024.

11. WITHDRAWALS

- (a) Notification of withdrawals of Exhibits must be forwarded to reach the Dog Section prior to 9am on the Exhibits day of Judging. This will NOT attract a withdrawal fee.
- (b) An Exhibit that does not parade and has not been withdrawn as required may at the discretion of the Council be excluded from admission as an Exhibit for the following year's Royal Easter Show.

12. RESPONSIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS

Attendance of a dog in the Assembly Ring when required for Judging shall be the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor.

13. SUITABLE COLLARS AND LEADS

- (a) A dog must be brought to the Show with a suitable collar and lead and at all times be led by such suitable collar and lead.
- (b) A dog when benched and not under the immediate control of the Exhibitor or Handler must be either in a suitable crate or tied up on its bench by a suitable collar and lead in such a way as to prevent the dog falling from the bench.

14. BENCHING

- (a) Only dogs on Exhibition for the particular day of judging will be permitted to be benched.
- (b) Bench numbers shall not be changed from one bench to another unless authorised in writing by the Committee. Any Person who without authority changes a bench number in manner aforesaid shall be liable to a Penalty of \$10.
- (c) (i) A board no larger than 450mm x 150mm displaying the registered Kennel and/or the dog's name and the official prize cards and ribbons for the current Show may be placed over the benches.
 - (ii) The Committee may require any sign considered to be inappropriate to be removed.
 - (iii) No prize cards other than those received as an Award at the Sydney Royal Easter Show may be displayed without the written approval of the Committee.
 - (iv) An Exhibitor must not display on their bench, or in any space, or on anything adjacent to or nearby their bench without limitation, including crates and trolleys, anything on which appears a name, logo, brand or other mark relating to an organisation that is commercially competitive with any other organisation that is a major sponsor of the Domestic Animals Section.

(d) In order to ensure a fair Competition, Breeder's identification through prefix branded clothing on or around an Exhibit is prohibited in the Marshalling Ring. This includes jackets and vests, jewellery, wristbands and anything that displays a breeder's prefix. Failure to adhere to this Regulation may result in the dog being disqualified.

15. REMOVAL FROM BENCH

A dog may not be removed from its bench between the hours set out in Special Dog Regulation 21, unless:

- (a) for the purpose of being judged;
- (b) (i) for the purpose of being exercised in the special area provided, or
 - (ii) for the purpose of being part of the Show as required by the Committee in which case permission from a Steward must be obtained;
- (c) the Exhibit is unfit to stay on the bench, in which case a Veterinary Certificate must be produced;
- (d) the Exhibitor has permission from the Committee of the RAS Domestic Animals Department;
- (e) dogs are NOT permitted to be led around the Showground. They must remain in the Competition precinct.

If an Exhibitor breaches this Regulation, then, at the discretion of the Committee, the Exhibitor and the Exhibit concerned may be refused entry at any future Exhibition or Show.

16. DOG ADMITTANCE

An Exhibit Confirmation Advice (Benchslip) will permit entry for the Exhibit/s & vehicle to enter the site for the purposes of delivering dogs during the specified delivery times only. It does not permit Exhibitors or parking on site. The vehicle must be removed from site immediately after the dog is delivered. The driver will need a valid Show Pass, Show Ticket or Exhibit Confirmation Advice (Benchslip) to re-enter the site on foot via the designated pedestrian entries. Vehicles or passengers without a valid pass will be denied entry and directed to contact the Domestic Animals Coordinator. Vehicles that remain on site illegally will be infringed.

17. ONLY EXHIBITS TO BE BROUGHT ON TO THE SHOWGROUND

An animal other than an Exhibit in respect of which an Application for Entry has been accepted by the RAS shall not be brought onto the Showground by any Exhibitor or other Person except with the consent of the RAS.

18. PASSES

Exhibitor passes will be allocated per judging days as follows:

1 to 2 dogs
2 One-Day Entry Pass ONLY
3 to 5 dogs
3 One-Day Entry Passes ONLY
6 or more dogs
4 One-Day Entry Passes ONLY

19. EXHIBIT UNWORTHY OF AWARD

The Judge may in his absolute discretion and without assigning any reason decline to make an Award in respect of any Exhibit.

20. PROTESTS

- (a) All protests shall be in writing and must be lodged in the Dog Administration Office within two (2) hours of the act or omission protested.
- (b) All protests shall be accompanied by a fee of \$150.

21. BENCHING TIMES

Any Exhibitor who is unable to observe the times below should not submit an entry:

(a) Breed Classes 9am to 5pm
(b) Sweepstake Classes 9am to 5pm
(c) Obedience Classes 8am to 5pm
(d) Agility Classes 7.30am to 5pm
(e) Handler Classes - dog 9am to 5pm
(f) Handler Classes - handler 11am to 5pm

22. STARTING TIMES

Any Exhibitor who is unable to observe the times below should not submit an entry:

(a) Breed Classes
(b) Sweepstake Classes
(c) Obedience Classes
(d) Agility Classes
(e) Handler Classes
10am

(f) General Specials 9am (pre-judging 8:30am)

23. PAVILION OPEN TO PUBLIC

The Pavilion or such portion of it as may be determined by the Steward-in-Chief will be open to the public between 9am and 5pm each day. It is a condition of entry that exhibits must remain in the pavilion until 5pm each day for exhibition to the public. Any exhibitor found to be violating these regulations will be fined and banned from returning to future shows.

24. JUDGE

The Committee reserves the right at all times at its absolute discretion without assigning any reason therefore to reallocate judging days or replace/substitute any Judge for particular breeds.

25. DUTY OF CARE

- (a) All Owners, Exhibitors and Handlers are required to comply with all applicable legislation, including but not limited to the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979 (NSW), Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Regulation 2012 (NSW), Exhibited Animals Protection Act 1986 (NSW), Exhibited Animals Protection Regulations 2010 (NSW) and the Companion Animal Act 1998 (NSW).
- (b) All Exhibits coming to the Show must at all times be under effective control by a competent Person.
- (c) An Exhibitor or nominated Person shall at all times exercise reasonable care, control and/or supervision of the Exhibit. An Exhibitor or nominated Person who brings an Exhibit to the Show, shall have a duty of care for their animal and to the community. This includes the comfort, safety and welfare of their animal and the interactions of any animal, and with any other Person or animal, at any time, whilst on-site at the Show.

26. HANDLING

Where the Person is handling the Exhibit they shall not act in a manner which unreasonably, unnecessarily or unjustifiably inflict pain upon the Exhibit. This includes acts that are deemed physical or psychological abuse.

27. PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

- (a) Please read General Regulations 126 137 inclusive.
- (b) Despite General Regulation 130(c), a Treatment Report Form must be submitted to the Dog Administration Office by 8.30am on the day of judging, except for Agility Exhibits which is required by 8am on the day of judging.
- (c) Prohibited Substance means any substance originating externally to an animal (and whether or not endogenous to the animal) capable of affecting the performance or behaviour of the animal by its action upon:
 - (i) the central or peripheral nervous system;
 - (ii) the cardiovascular system;
 - (iii) the respiratory system;
 - (iv) the alimentary digestive system;
 - (v) the musculo-skeletal system; or
 - (vi) the urogenital system, and includes without limitation:
 - (i) analgesics;
 - (ii) anti-histamines;
 - (iii) anti-inflammatory agents;
 - (iv) blood coagulants;
 - (v) diuretics;
 - (vi) hormones and their synthetic counterparts;
 - (vii) cortico-steroids;
 - (viii) anabolic steroids;
 - (ix) local anaesthetics;
 - (x) muscle relaxants;
 - (xi) tranquillisers;
 - (xii) vitamins;
 - (xiii) antibiotics; and
 - (xiv) stimulants.

28. AGGRESSIVE DOGS

- (a) It is the obligation of each Owner, Exhibitor and Handler at a Show to take all such steps as may be necessary to ensure that any dog under that Person's care or control or for which that Person is responsible does not behave in an aggressive manner.
- (b) It is the obligation of any Person at a Show who observes a dog behaving in an aggressive manner to report the incident either orally or in writing to a member of the Committee as soon as possible after the incident.
- (c) If the Committee is satisfied that the incident comprised or included the dog attacking, or attempting to attack, any Person or another dog at the Show, the Committee may declare the dog to be an aggressive dog.
- (d) The Committee shall advise in writing, on the day, the Person who appears to be responsible for the care and control of an aggressive dog of its declaration as such.
- (e) Forthwith upon the Committee declaring a dog to be an aggressive dog:
 - the Owner, Exhibitor or Handler responsible for the dog shall forthwith remove the dog from the Showground;
 - (ii) the dog shall ipso facto be disqualified from further Exhibition at the Show in question or at any other Show. During the period of such disqualification the dog shall not be allowed to enter or remain upon any showground.

29. COMPLIANCE WITH DIRECTIONS

Each Exhibitor must comply with any direction given by any Official of the RAS. This includes Veterinary Officials and staff. Failure to comply could result in removal from the precinct and subsequent refusal of future entries.

30. PRIZES

Special Prizes for individual breeds, except those decided by Class Awards, unless otherwise stated, shall be judged on the day on which the particular breed is judged. Special Prizes shall be restricted to the age Class stated in the conditions. Special Prizes which are confined to a number of breeds shall be judged on Monday 1 April 2024

31. DISPUTES

Any dispute or difference and any inquiry into any alleged misconduct or breach of the Rules or Regulations applicable to the Show shall be dealt with by the Committee unless referred to the Disciplinary Committee pursuant to the General Regulations and the decision of that Committee shall be final and binding and shall not be subject to any appeal.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES

The purpose of competition at the Sydney Royal Easter Show is to encourage agricultural and pastoral excellence, ensuring the continual improvement of standards. In the 1870s the Society introduced Regulations to govern judges and judging to ensure that competition was consistent and fair, and the tradition of Perpetual Trophies dates back to this time.

The Perpetual Trophies are the most prestigious of all RAS Awards. They have a dual function in recognising superior effort in competition and commemorating people and organisations that have had a long and meritorious connection with the Society.
