It is with great pleasure that the Royal Agricultural Society (RAS) of New South Wales invites your school to apply for the 2025 Sydney Royal Easter Show (SRES) All Roads to the Royal Program. The program offers a unique, fully funded experience of the SRES from Monday 14 April – Thursday 17 April 2025. This program, has been designed by the RAS Youth Group, which consists of individuals, aged 18-35, who are passionate about Australian agriculture and capturing the potential of young people within rural, regional and remote NSW.

The Sydney Royal Easter Show is a celebration of Australian culture, from rural traditions to modernday lifestyles, it provides a unique experience for everyone. Every Easter, the country and city become one within Sydney Showground, for twelve days of agricultural competitions and education, animal experiences, live entertainment, carnival fun, shopping and much more

All Roads to the Royal is a fully funded initiative supported by the RAS Foundation. Funding includes all transport, accommodation and meals with an itinerary that includes exclusive behind the scenes tours of the show and incomparable, syllabus based, hands on experiences for your students. This program facilitates a maximum of forty people, including teachers, support staff and parents. Students can range from years 7-12 and it is hoped the program will inspire students to pursue a career that contributes to Australian agriculture. This experience aims to address the disproportionate access to the Sydney Royal Easter Show for rural students who are geographically isolated, as well as fostering student interest in agriculture, through exposure to industry leaders and world class competitions.

First held in 1823, the show is Australia's largest ticketed event, attracting over 850,000 attendees every year! Revenue generated allows the RAS to invest in agricultural programs, competitions, education, youth, and rural NSW. The RAS invests almost \$7 million annually in activations across NSW, which are designed to promote agricultural excellence and regional NSW. All Roads to the Royal is a great opportunity for students in rural NSW to experience first-hand what the Royal Agricultural Society of NSW has to offer and the work we do to promote them and their communities.

- The selected school will be a rural and/ or remote school as determined by the Department of Education.
- Schools which submit the 5-minute video to complete the application will be looked on favorably.
- Schools' involvement in agriculture and/or local show will be considered as part of the selection process.
- Overall, schools are assessed based on their responses to questions, and how the program can help to facilitate further involvement in agriculture and agricultural show societies.
- With guidance from the Youth Affairs committee, the RAS Youth Group's decision is final.
