JUDGING COMPETITIONS AND THE PARADING OF EXHIBITS.

General Regulation No. 57A.

Every livestock exhibit shall be prepared whenever and wheresoever required by the Society during and throughout the conduct of any Judging Competition and shall be subject to such comment, criticism, and handling as may be considered by the Society reasonably necessary or desirable for purposes of instruction, judging or explanation as incidental to the conduct of such Competition and no owner or exhibitor shall take exception thereto provided that whilst parading in the Judging Competition the exhibit shall not carry breast plate or other means of identification unless so required by the Society.

(SPECIAL PRIZES).—£10 10s., presented by The Australian Broadcasting Commission, 264 Pitt-st., Sydney. First, £5; second, £3; third, £2 10s. Restricted to first, second and third prize winners in the Beef Cattle Judging Competitions, Classes 4 to 8. The Steward-in-Chief shall select four animals from a beef breed for judging. The competition will be conducted on lines similar to those obtaining for the animal classes but, in addition, competitors will be required to state reasons for their awards through a microphone and to answer such questions as the Judge might ask.

CONDITIONS.

- The competitions shall be for competitors who have not reached their 27th birthday at time of competition. DATE OF BIRTH MUST BE SHOWN ON CERTIFICATE OF ENTRY. In substantiation of the age of any competitor, the Steward-in-Chief may call for a Statutory Declaration.
- The competition shall be open to students of Agricultural Colleges, Agricultural High Schools, Junior Farmers' Clubs, and others outside the foregoing classifications within the prescribed age limits. In any class the number of competitors from an Agricultural College, High School, or like institution, shall be restricted to three. A student from any of the said institutions or Junior Farmers' Clubs shall not be eligible to compete unless he has been officially nominated by the institution or club to which he belongs—such nominees must individually submit and sign the entry form. There shall be no restriction on the number of other individual competitors.
- "Post" entries and "Substitute" entries will not be accepted, except in the case of a N.S.W. Junior Farmer, officially notified to the Society by the State Organiser as having been selected for the Junior Farmers' Show Camp after 1st February, 1960.
- The number of animals to be judged in each competition shall be four.
- Unless otherwise specified, there shall be a "breed" judge and an "assessor" judge.
- There shall be a maximum judging time allowance of 25 minutes for the animal classes and 20 minutes for the agriculture classes, within which all judging cards as supplied by the Society must be completed and handed to the Steward in charge.
- A competitor may enter in more than one of the specified groups, viz., Arabs, Clydesdales, Pony, Beef Cattle, Fat Cattle (any breed), Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Pigs, Poultry, Turkeys, but he is restricted to any one class in each group. (In the Agriculture classes this restriction does not apply).

ANIMAL CLASSES.

- The competitors and the judge will be provided with cards on which they will be required to record:—
 - under each of about six specified headings—
 - the main defect for each animal;
 - the order of merit;
 - for final placings—
 - comparative comment on good and bad qualities of the four animals;
 - the final order of merit.

- The maximum marks to be awarded for each section of the card are:—
 - for "Comments"—under each heading (See 1a (i))—2 per animal;—under final placings (See 1b (i))—4 per animal.
 - for "Placings"—under each heading (See 1a (ii))—five marks for each heading;—for final placings (See 1b (ii))—fifteen marks

- The "assessor" judge will compare each competitor's card with that of the "breed" judge and will mark it in accordance with the previously agreed on rating. "Nil" or a reduced number of marks will be allotted for "placings" not supported by appropriate "comments."
- The competitor gaining the highest total number of marks shall be the winner. In the event of a tie in total marks, the marks awarded for comments on final placings—see 1b (i)—will then be the deciding factor.
- At the conclusion of the judging in each class the "breed" judge will give a talk on judging and will discuss the exhibits judged.

AGRICULTURE CLASSES.

- In these classes (Wheat, Maize, Potatoes) competitors are required to complete similar cards to those used in the animal classes.
- Wheat and maize will be judged for seed and show qualities. Potatoes will be judged for "conformity to varietal type" and "commercial condition."
- The "location" of the Agriculture Classes is—Sinclair Park.
