JUDGING DAYS.

Judging will commence at:—

7 a.m., Friday, 8th April—Pork and Bacon Pig Carcasses—Classes 55 and 56.
9.30 a.m., Friday, 8th April—Stud Classes.

PAVILION OPEN TO PUBLIC.

The Pavilion shall be open to the public daily from 9.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. except Monday, 11th April, and Good Friday, 15th April, on which days the pavilion will close at 5 p.m.

FODDER.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to arrange for his fodder requirements. The sale of all fodder is in the hands of the Official Produce Merchant, whose store on the Showground will be open during the Show.

Fodder shall not be admitted to or removed from the Showground without authority. For purposes of admission, a written order must be presented to the gatekeeper by the exhibitor or his representative, or by an outside merchant when making deliveries on behalf of an exhibitor. In the case of removal an official pass-out check is required. Admission orders and pass-out checks are obtainable from the Director.

For the convenience of exhibitors or other persons specially authorised to enter or leave the Showground with fodder, gates have been allocated as follows:—

- (i) Entry—Furber Road.
- (ii) Exit—(a) From the Horse Section—Lang Road.
(b) from the Cattle and Pig Section—Paddington.

Conveyances may enter the Showground between 6 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. and must leave by 9.30 a.m. on ordinary days, or by 9 a.m. on Good Friday, Easter Saturday, and Easter Monday.

TROPHIES ON DISPLAY.

Trophies offered for competition in the Pig Section shall be on display in the special windows, provided for the purpose, in the Society's General Showground Office.

PUBLIC AUCTION SALE OF PIGS.

Each selling Agent shall sell in the same order as the catalogued lots.

For the 1960 Royal Easter Show the breeds shall be sold during three days as hereunder stated:—
Tuesday, 8th April, commencing at 11 a.m.—Porkers and Baconers, at Homebush, N.S.W. State Abattoir Pig Saleyard.
Tuesday, 12th April, at 9.30 a.m.—Landrace; Large Whites.
Wednesday, 13th April, at 9.30 a.m.—Tamworths; Herefords.

For future years the breeds sold on the Tuesday and Wednesday shall rotate as will the breeds on the stated days. The Selling Agents shall print a combined catalogue. In rotational order, the Agents responsible for the printing of the sale catalogue shall be:—

All Pigs offered for sale must comply with the requirements of the New South Wales Swine Branding Act (1940).

SPECIAL PIG REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

All pigs (except those entered for bacon classes) over five months old must be registered with the Australian Pig Society, or a recognised Pig Stud Book Society. Pigs, including litters in sow and litter classes, must be from litters duly notified in accordance with the rules of the Australian Pig Society. For particulars apply to Branch Secretaries:—Lt.-Gen. No animal other than an exhibit in respect of which application for entry has been accepted by the Society shall be brought on to the Showground by any exhibitor or other person except with the consent of the Director.

No animal other than an exhibit shall be displayed or exposed for sale on the Showground.

Every exhibitor warrants that he is the absolute owner of every animal brought by him or by his authority on to the Showground and agrees to indemnify and shall indemnify the Society against all claims on whatsoever ground and for whatsoever cause made against the Society in respect of such animal at the instance of any other person.

PENALTY—NON-EXHIBITION OF PIGS.

In order to prevent the non-exhibition of animals which have been entered for the Show, thus causing unnecessary preparation, expense, and disarrangement of the Show yard, any person making any entry will be subject to a fine of 10s. for each and every entry of pigs not exhibited, unless a certificate under the hand of the exhibitor or his authorised agent be lodged with the Director of the Society before the day of exhibition, to the effect that such non-exhibition is caused either by (1) the death of the animal or animals; or (2) contagious or infectious disease (confirmed by an explanatory certificate of a veterinary surgeon); or (3) by its becoming ineligible for the class in which it has been entered, or other reasonable cause. The non-payment of such fines to debar all persons owing them from exhibiting at future exhibitions of the Society.

Age of pigs (litter classes excepted) to be calculated from the birth date shown in the litter registration in the herd book up to 1st April.

The age of pigs in litter classes shall be actual age at the date of judging (Friday, 8th April, 1960).

The name and breeding particulars of a boar or sow entered in a class for exhibits born after 1st November, 1959, may be furnished prior to the closing date of entries, or not later than the day before judging. Failure to observe this provision will automatically cancel the entry.

Full particulars must be stated on the certificate of entry of age, pedigree, herd book number if available. In the case where no number is available, proof of acceptance for herd book must be produced, except where otherwise specified.

No pig shall be entered for a class for which it is not eligible on account of age. Exhibitors may be disqualified and debarred from further competition for any breach of this by-law.

No pig over 17 months of age shall be eligible to compete unless the date of farrowing of the last progeny produced is shown on the certificate of entry.

Boars over 12 months old must have had their tusks cut down within six weeks of judging day. Upon arrival on the Showground all boars, over 12 months old, will be inspected by the Superintendent of the Section to ensure that this regulation has been observed. Exhibits not conforming with this regulation will be attended to by the Society's Veterinary Surgeon at the cost of the exhibitor.

All pigs exhibited with a sow shall be her own progeny and not exceeding eight weeks old on day of judging (Friday, 8th April, 1960).

Any sow entered in a sow and litter class, which has not farrowed at the time of judging, may compete in a dry class or vice versa. Such transferred entry shall be additional to any entries made by the exhibitor in the relative class. The exhibitor must advise the Director as early as possible to enable the transfer to be effected before the time of judging.

All pigs exhibited in group classes must be paraded and judged as a group, and not on their awards in individual classes.

First and second prize sows in litter classes may compete individually for Championship and Reserve Championship prizes as defined hereunder.

In awarding the Championship, the Junior Champion, and first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section shall be eligible to compete.

In awarding the Reserve Championship, the first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section, other than the exhibit to which the Championship has been awarded, shall be eligible to compete, together with the second prize winner in the class in which the Champion was awarded first prize.

In awarding the Junior Championship, the first prize winner of the relative sex in each class of the relative Sub-section shall be eligible to compete provided that no exhibit shall be eligible to compete for the Junior Championship if it is over 12 months old.

In awarding the Reserve Junior Championship, the first prize winner in each class in the relative Sub-Section, other than the exhibit to which the Junior Championship has been awarded, shall be eligible to compete together with the second prize winner in the class from which the Junior Champion was drawn provided that no exhibit shall be eligible to compete for the Reserve Junior Championship if it is over 12 months old.

Where there is only one exhibitor in a class there shall be only one award.

Each Selling Agent who makes a sale or sales of pigs situated on the Showground or of pigs after leaving the Showground but before the pigs have reached the destination to which they were sent from the Showground shall pay to the Society a rental equivalent to one per cent of the gross proceeds of the sale or sales.

The removal from an exhibit of any natural markings or interference by staining, or otherwise, to disassemble natural markings will entail disqualification, and the exhibitor will be dealt with as the Council may deem fit.

Exhibitors from other States should obtain from the Stock Branches of their own State and N.S.W. a "Permit to travel" before arranging to despatch the pigs to Sydney.

All pigs shall be fed and attended to by the exhibitor, who shall be responsible for the cleanliness and proper condition of the sites while the pigs remain on the Showground, both before and after the pig sales, and shall be subject to the control of the Superintendent of the Section appointed by the Society. The pigs must be fed and pens cleaned out by 7 a.m. daily.

In the event of any pig being unfed, or any sty being in improper condition at any time while the pig remains on the Showground, both before and after the pig sales, the officials of the Society shall feed and attend to the pig, and the cost of such feed and attendance shall be borne by the exhibitor of the pig.

Any exhibitor who may neglect to feed and properly attend to all pigs exhibited by him during the period through which they remain in the sites, either before or after the pig sales, shall be liable to disqualification after enquiry by the Council.

No pig shall be removed from its numbered pen without the sanction of the Superintendent.

Each exhibitor or his representative will be allowed to get in the pen and show his pig to the Judge, and must remain in the pen until the Judge has finished with that exhibit.

The Superintendent will take delivery on Showground of all exhibits, and at close of Show will deliver same and issue pass-out checks and return railway certificates.

EXHIBITS MUST REMAIN ON EXHIBITION UNTIL THE COMPLETION OF THE DAY SESSION (6 P.M.) ON THE LAST DAY OF THE SHOW, TUESDAY, 9th APRIL.

All exhibits, except for Classes 55 and 56, must be penned by 8.30 a.m. on Thursday, 7th April. Judging to commence at 9.30 a.m. on Friday, 8th April. Exhibits entered in Classes 55 and 56 must be penned not later than 8 a.m. Thursday, 7th April.

INSPECTOR'S VERIFICATION OF TYPE, DESCRIPTION AND ELIGIBILITY.

- Each animal shall be subject to inspection at any time on or before the day immediately preceding judging day by an inspector or inspectors appointed by the Society.
- If any such inspector shall certify that in his opinion
 - the animal is not true to type, or

- (ii) is not of such description or merit as to be a worthy exhibit in the class or classes in which it is entered, or
- (iii) such animal bears any marking, whether in the nature of colour, tattoo, fire or other brand, surgical operation, or otherwise contrary to the markings disclosed in the relative certificate of entry, or does not show some such marking attributed to it in the relative certificate of entry or if any such marking or absence of marking is not in accordance with the particulars furnished in respect of such animal by the relative breed society,

the Society may require the animal to be forthwith removed from the Showground and the exhibitor, upon receipt of such notice shall forthwith remove such animal and failing such removal by him within the time prescribed by the Director the Director may remove the animal or cause the animal to be removed and all costs and expenses of removal shall be borne by the exhibitor and shall be refunded to the Society. Each such animal shall at all times be deemed to be the agents of the exhibitor and all acts and omissions on the part of such person or persons shall be deemed to be the acts and omissions of the exhibitor who shall indemnify and hold indemnified the Society its servants and agents from all claims whatsoever in respect of the animal whether by reason of any loss or injury to or caused by the animal or because of transportation, feeding or housing or otherwise howsoever.

- (e) No inspector shall be required to furnish to the exhibitor any reasons for his determination nor shall there be any appeal against such determination at the instance of the exhibitor provided always that the Steward-in-Chief or Assistant Steward-in-Chief of the Pig Section of the particular class in which such animal is entered for exhibition may override any such determination and permit the animal to remain on the Showground with or without the right of being paraded and/or exhibited as such Steward-in-Chief or Assistant Steward-in-Chief may, in his absolute discretion, determine.
- (d) The Australian Pig Society (N.S.W. Branch) shall be requested to nominate three persons qualified to act as inspectors in order to facilitate the appointment of an inspector or inspectors by the Society for the purpose of this regulation.

DATES OF BIRTH FOR CLASSES RESTRICTED BY AGE.

Stated hereunder is an explanation regarding classes which restrict the eligibility of an exhibit by the fact of its age. The dates shown within the parentheses are those on, or between which, the exhibit must be born to enable it to compete in the class referred to immediately preceding the parentheses.

Over 17 months and not over 4 years

(1st April, 1958—31st Oct., 1958);

Over 12 and not over 17 months

(1st Nov., 1958—31st March, 1959);

Over 8 and not over 12 months

(1st April—31st July, 1959);

Over 8 and not over 8 months

(1st Aug.—31st Oct., 1959);

Not over 7 months (on or after 1st Sept., 1959);

Not over 5 months (on or after 1st Nov., 1959);

Not over 4 months (on or after 1st Dec., 1959);

Litter not over 8 weeks (on or after 12th Feb., 1960).

SPECIAL NOTICE. PIG STUDENTS.

Students from the Hawkesbury Agricultural College and the Veterinary School of the Sydney University will be appointed for the purpose of assisting exhibitors with the preparation of their pigs. Such assistance shall be available from the day before judging of the breed up to and including the day on which the breed is sold by Public Auction during the currency of the Show. Exhibitors desiring students must state on their Certificate of Entry the number they require. They shall also undertake to pay 10s. per day, for each student, towards the Society's expenses incurred by the appointment of the students. Should an exhibitor desire the services of students at an earlier or until a later date, the cost for the extra period shall be borne wholly by the exhibitor. Unless the aforesaid is observed the students shall not be available.

Should it be found following the closing date for receipt of entries that the available penning accommodation is insufficient, the Committee reserves the right to further reduce the number of entries which may be accepted in any class or classes.

RAILWAY CERTIFICATES.

Certificates granting reduced rail carriage of pigs, returning to the station they were trucked from must be obtained at the Superintendent's office. These certificates must be obtained before the pigs leave the ground and must be presented at the time of consigning. Otherwise Full Trainage will be Charged. A concession rail certificate will not be issued unless the exhibit is returned to the station whence it was trucked within four weeks of the date of the forward journey.

THE "A. F. GRAY" MEMORIAL TROPHY.

(Special Prize)—The "A. F. Gray Memorial Trophy" (comprising a Shield and Memento), value £28 5s. Trophy presented by The Australian Pig Society (N.S.W. Branch), Endeavour House, 33 Macquarie Place, Sydney, for the Most Successful Exhibitor at Royal Easter Shows to be allocated to the said exhibitor in the breed for the year stated, viz.:—1960, Berkshire; 1961, Large Whites; 1962, Tamworth; 1963, Landrace; 1964, Pork and Bacon Classes; and thereafter shall rotate in the order shown. The award shall be determined as follows:—For the five highest awards in each class points shall be allotted on the basis of 8, 5, 3, 2, and 1. Should there be fewer than five awards in any one class, the points shall be on the said basis in order of merit. In addition, there shall be three points for Champion, two for Reserve Champion, two for Junior Champion, and one for Reserve Junior Champion. Gray Memorial Trophy" (Shield and Memento), before becoming the outright possession of one exhibitor, must be won on three occasions. The Shield shall be held by the winner until within one month of the succeeding Royal Easter Show, when it shall be returned to the Society. The Shield and Memento shall be suitably engraved with the name of each yearly winner.

One point will be deducted for each 2lb. above or below the specified cold dressed weight limits in Classes 55 and 56.

Each pig entered in classes 55 and 56 will be sent to the State Abattoir, Homebush Bay Sydney, where it will be killed, dressed and weighed as a carcass. For the purpose of identification, each pig sent to the State Abattoir will be body-tattooed by the Society. Carcasses condemned in whole or part at the Abattoir will be disqualified.

The carcasses will be judged, on a cold weight basis, in accordance with the abovementioned points and in the course of the judging each carcass will be cut into sides, one of which will be cut in half at the last rib.

At the conclusion of the carcass judging the first prizewinning carcasses (Pork and Bacon classes) will be hung in the Metropolitan Meat Industry Board's refrigerated cabinet at the Royal Agricultural Society's Show, where they will remain until the termination of the Show. In addition a number of loin cuts taken from carcasses selected by the judge will be displayed. Any loss occasioned by the cutting up of the carcasses shall be borne by the exhibitor/s. Delivery of unselected carcasses shall be made immediately after judging. The Judge's decision will be final.

SPECIAL NOTE—The New South Wales Swine Branding Act (1940) states inter alia "all pigs submitted for slaughter in this State must be branded with the owner's registered brand within 7 days of date of slaughter". Any animal not branded in accordance with this condition may be disqualified.

Pigs must be penned not later than 8 a.m. on the morning of Thursday, 7th April. Thereafter they will be body-tattooed and despatched to the State Abattoir, Homebush Bay.

Classes 55 and 56 will be judged at the State Abattoir, Homebush Bay, Sydney, on the morning of Friday, 8th April.

Trophies offered for competition in the Wines, Spirits, Liqueurs, and Cider Section shall be on display in the special windows provided for the purpose in the Society's General Showground Office.

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS.

In accordance with the recommendation made by the Federal Viticultural Council of Australia that a Championship Show shall be conducted in, and only in, the State in which the Federal Viticultural Council of Australia's Annual Conference is held, there shall be Championship Awards in the Wine and Brandy Sub-Section of the 1960 Royal Easter Show.

JUDGES' AWARDS.

Judges' awards will not be released until Wednesday, 2nd March, 1960.

SPECIAL WINES AND BRANDY REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

The attention of exhibitors is directed particularly to Clauses 12 and 14 hereunder, relating to the preparation of exhibits.

1. All classes are open for competition to wine growers and wine and spirit merchants.
2. A wine merchant shall mean any person, association, or company buying wine and brandy.
3. A wine grower shall mean any wine grower owning or occupying a vineyard, and manufacturing wine from grapes grown in such vineyard, or from grapes purchased for the purpose of winemaking.
4. Exhibitors may either be Members, Associate-Members, or Non-Members of the Society. Entry Fee—Members and Associate-Members, 7s. 6d.; Non-Members, 12s. 6d.
5. Exhibitors will be allowed up to three entries in any one class with the exception of Class 30 (Collection of Wines) for which only one entry will be allowed. Each entry to consist of six quart (reputed) bottles. Exhibitors entering the same wine in more than one class must supply the full number of sample bottles for each entry.
6. Wines may be graded on points.
