REGULATIONS

- N.B.—A class will be created for every individual variety of fish exhibited.
1. Exhibits must be shown in standard aquariums of the following approximate sizes—18 inches x 12 inches; 24 inches x 12 or 14 inches; 30 inches x 18 inches; 36 inches x 18 inches. As many entries as possible to be shown in the one aquarium.
 2. Exhibitors must supply their own aquaria.
 3. Goldfish, Sharks and Siamese Fighters are to be shown singly and Tropical fish in pairs. Where the sex cannot be determined two fish will constitute a pair.
 4. Prize cards will be given for the first three place getters in each class.
 5. The champion fish of each group of fish will be awarded a cash prize, or trophy if donated.
 6. Entries are not restricted to one per tank. In order that the space allocation may be planned, exhibitors are required to indicate on the entry form the exact face size of each aquarium. The entry form must also show which fish will be exhibited in each aquarium.
 7. Any number of pairs of different species of fish may be shown in one aquarium but an entry fee must be paid for each pair in their species.
 8. Aquaria must be covered with clear glass supplied by the exhibitor. They may be erected and in position from Saturday, 2nd April, at 9 a.m. Exhibits must be placed in the aquaria not later than 9 p.m. on Thursday, 7th April.
 9. Aquaria for both Goldfish and Tropical fish (other than Classes for Community Tanks) may be planted, but only lightly.
 10. Representative fishes of each specie will be judged separately.
 11. **Aeration:** Filters, stones, clamps and sufficient plastic tube to connect to the main air line at the back of the aquaria must be supplied by the exhibitor. The Society will provide sufficient air for all aquaria.
 12. Aquaria which leak will be withdrawn from exhibition.
 13. All lighting will be supplied by the Society.
 14. Any fish which does not display itself at time of judging will be disqualified.
 15. Heating equipment for Tropical fish shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor. All electrical equipment must be earthed, heaters and lighting wired separately and all wiring must be in accordance with specifications as laid down by the County Council. The Society will provide all necessary power points. Access to the exhibit will be given on the week end prior to the opening day.
 16. An exhibitor shall not remove his exhibit from its position during the currency of the Royal Easter Show but may remove it after 9 p.m. on Tuesday, 19th April.
 17. Exhibits may be supervised and fed by one or more officials nominated by the Federation of N.S.W. Aquarium Societies unless a request "Do not feed" be made by the exhibitor in the application form and private arrangements for feeding be also made with the stewards. Exhibits will be under the control of stewards appointed by the Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W.
 18. Goldfish will be judged according to the standards adopted by the Aquarium Society of N.S.W. and are classified as "Carp."
 19. Neither the Society nor any Steward or official of the Society shall be held responsible for any loss injury or death even though allegedly caused or contributed to by some negligent act or omission.
