TROPHIES ON DISPLAY.

Trophies offered for competition in the Wines, Spirits, Liqueurs, and Cider Section shall be on display in the special windows provided for the purpose in the Society's General Showground Office.

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS.

In accordance with the recommendation made by the Federal Viticultural Council of Australia that a Championship Show shall be conducted in, and only in, the State in which the Federal Viticultural Council of Australia's Annual Conference is held, there shall be Championship Awards in the Wine and Brandy Sub-Section of the 1960 Royal Easter Show.

JUDGES' AWARDS.

Judges' awards will not be released until Wednesday, 2nd March, 1960.

SPECIAL WINES AND BRANDY REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

The attention of exhibitors is directed particularly to Clauses 12 and 14 hereunder, relating to the preparation of exhibits.

- All classes are open for competition to wine growers and wine and spirit merchants.
- A wine merchant shall mean any person, association, or company buying wine and brandy.
- A wine grower shall mean any wine grower owning or occupying a vineyard, and manufacturing wine from grapes grown in such vineyard, or from grapes purchased for the purpose of winemaking.
- Exhibitors may either be Members, Associate-Members, or Non-Members of the Society. Entry Fee—Members and Associate-Members, 7s. 6d.; Non-Members, 12s. 6d.
- Exhibitors will be allowed up to three entries in any one class with the exception of Class 20 (Collection of Wines) for which only one entry will be allowed. Each entry to consist of six quart (reputed) bottles. Exhibitors entering the same wine in more than one class must supply the full number of sample bottles for each entry.
- Wines may be judged on points.

7. An exhibitor may be awarded more than one prize in any one class.
8. The judges may make awards on the basis of First, Second, Third, Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended, and Commended, but prize money will only be allocated for first and second awards.
9. Entries must be made on forms supplied by the Society for that purpose. Exhibitors must state on the certificate of entry the class to be competed for, the distinguishing mark on the exhibits, character and vintage of the wine, and, when stipulated, the quantity in stock.
10. No person will be allowed to inspect a certificate of entry, after reception by the Director, until the judges' awards have been made public.
11. After the close of entries, no person will be permitted access to the exhibits, except the Judges, Stewards, Director and Staff until the awards have been made.
12. Exhibits are to bear the labels supplied by the Society for that purpose, and must show:—
(a) The year of the Competition (1960).
(b) The number of the class.
(c) Where more than one entry, the distinguishing mark of the entry to conform to the certificate of entry.
(d) The year of vintage.
(N.B.—Bottles must not bear any labels other than those supplied by the Society. Branded bottles and corks are permissible).
13. Sparkling wines must represent wines with natural effervescence, the result of fermentation in bottle. Stock in hand at date of entry to be not less than 100 dozen reputed quarts or 200 dozen reputed pints.
14. Exhibits to be delivered to the Overseer's Office at the Showground in cases properly marked to show exhibitor's name, not later than Friday, 29th January, 1960.
15. In all classes, the wine in stock as stated on the certificate of entry may be inspected and checked by a representative of the Society or its nominee. Each exhibitor must supply the Society with a sealed envelope containing the record of any sale made subsequent to their entries being lodged, provided such sale has reduced the stipulated quantity below the minimum.
16. Immediately after the closing date of entries a draw will be made for the selection of three exhibitors from whose entries a further draw will be made to enable one sample to be selected from each exhibitor. An official appointed by the Society shall make an inspection of the quantity of such wine in accordance with the certificate of entry and his report will be later considered by the Committee.
17. All exhibits to become the property of the Society.
18. Exhibits must represent stocks as set out on the certificate of entry and be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.
19. All wine exhibits must be the sole produce of Australian grapes and free from any foreign substance. The Society reserves the right to have any exhibit inspected and/or analysed by one or more persons appointed for that purpose.
20. All exhibits must conform to the respective Wine or Food Acts of the States of New South Wales, Victoria, and South Australia.
21. No protest will be entertained unless made within 7 days of the announcement of the awards.
22. No entry will be received from any person or persons disqualified by this or any other similar Society during the period of such disqualification. Should any entry be accepted, it shall, when discovered, be deemed void and the entry fee and exhibit shall be forfeited to the Society.
23. All persons exhibiting shall accept the decision of the judges appointed by the Society as to the merits of their exhibits.
24. No exhibitor or representative or employee of an exhibitor may occupy the position of Judge or become in any way identified with the judging or handling of exhibits, in any class in which he or his employer is interested. This rule shall not apply to stewards appointed for training experience only.
25. No exhibitor shall advertise or allow to be advertised by any means whatsoever and whether by broadcasting, pictorially, or in writing, the fact that any exhibit has won any prize in this section unless such advertisement shows clearly:
(a) Year of award;
(b) Description of class with vintage year where applicable;
(c) Type of wine.
26. Any competitor making improper use of prizes won in the Wine Section for advertising purposes will be subject to disqualification.

INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES.

1. The judges shall have power to disqualify or disqualify, as being not eligible for judging, any exhibit which, in their opinion, does not comply with the regulations in every respect, and such disqualification shall be accepted as final. The judges shall have power to call in one or more persons, not being exhibitors, for consultative or advisory purposes.
2. In the event of there being no competition in a class, judges may award a prize or not, as they think fit. Prizes may be withheld in any class where exhibits are considered unworthy.
3. Subject to the provisions of Regulation 5, a wine entered in a wrong class may, at the discretion of the judges, be transferred to the class for which it is eligible.

EXHIBITS.

All sections open to growers and merchants.
The quantity in stock must (unless otherwise specified) be not less than the following, viz.:—Vintage, 1959, 500 gallons; Vintage, 1958, 500 gallons or 250 dozen quarts, if bottled; Vintage, 1957 (or older), 200 gallons or 100 dozen quarts, if bottled. An exhibition sample shall consist of six quart (reputed) bottles.

WHISKY AND RUM CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS—ADDITIONAL SAMPLES TO BE SUBMITTED.

Exhibitors desiring their exhibits to be eligible for championship of its class shall be required to submit with their entries two additional samples of each exhibit in the Overproof classes reduced to a strength between 30° and 33° U.P.

The object of this suggestion is to ensure that the Spirits when being judged for the championship of its class will have been sufficiently "married" in preference to the present practice of the Judges adding the required quantity of water at the time of judging to bring the strength of the exhibit (whatever it may be) to between 30° and 33° U.P. This ensures a more equitable standard of Spirit for the judging of the Championship.

A Champion Award may be made each for: Whisky, Rum, and Gin. See Special Prizes (Caps and replicas) presented by The Wine and Spirit Merchants' Association of N.S.W.

AUSTRALIAN WHISKY, RUM, GIN, VODKA, LIQUEURS, AND CIDER SPECIAL REGULATIONS.

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to this section only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

The attention of exhibitors is directed particularly to Clause 12 hereunder relating to the preparation of exhibits.

1. Exhibitors of whisky, gin, rum, vodka, liqueurs, and cider, must, with their certificate of entry, give an undertaking to abide by these Regulations.
2. Exhibitors may either be Members, Associate-Members, or Non-Members of the Society. Entry Fee—Members and Associate-Members, 7s. 6d.; Non-Members, 12s. 6d.
3. Each exhibitor will be allowed up to three entries in any one class, except for liqueurs which shall be restricted to one entry of any one brand in each class.
4. No person shall enter any whisky, gin, rum, or cider as an exhibit unless he has in stock, available for sale, a supply of such spirit as stipulated in respect of each class of exhibit hereunder. A margin of variation of 2° in strength to be allowed for any exhibit, unless otherwise stated.
5. (a) Liqueurs must be made from natural extracts or flavourings and must not contain synthetic flavourings. Exhibitors must state on the certificate of entry and the label the spirit content of the liqueur exhibited; a margin of variation in strength of 2° will be allowed for any exhibit unless otherwise stated.
(b) No person shall enter any liqueur as an exhibit unless it has been drawn from bond, from one repack which has been executed during the 12 months prior to the closing date for receipt of entries. The quantity of such repack must be at least that which is stipulated for the class.
(c) One reputed quart sample drawn from, and bearing the number of the repack from which the exhibit has been drawn is to be retained by the exhibitor until after the announcement of the awards, and is to be made available to the Society for tasting upon request.
(d) The Customs repack number for each liqueur exhibit is to be stated on the certificate of entry and the label.
6. Exhibits must represent stocks as set out on certificate of entry, and be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry or, in the case of liqueurs, at the time of manufacture.
7. No entry will be received from any person or persons disqualified by this or any other similar Society during the period of such disqualification. Should any such entry be accepted, it shall, when discovered, be deemed void and the entry fee and exhibit shall be forfeited to the Society.

8. No person, except as hereinafter stated, will be allowed to inspect a certificate of entry, after reception by the Director, until the judges' awards have been made public. To ensure that an exhibitor has entered in the correct section, a sub-committee comprising members of the Society's Wine Section Committee and The Wine and Spirit Merchants' Association of N.S.W. shall vet the applications after the closing date of entries.
9. Immediately after the closing date of entries a draw will be made for the selection of three exhibitors from whose entries a further draw will be made to enable one sample to be selected from each exhibitor. An official appointed by the Society shall make an inspection of the quantity in accordance with the certificate of entry, and his reports will be later considered by the Committee.
10. After the close of entries no person will be permitted access to the exhibits, except the Judges, Stewards, Director, and Staff, until the awards have been made.
11. The acceptance of each entry shall be subject to:—(a) that it conforms with these regulations; (b) that it has not been subjected to any treatment since its release from Bond; and (c) that it has not been blended with any imported spirit or liqueur.
12. (a) Each exhibit must consist of two reputed quarts or four reputed pints drawn from bond and must be of the alcoholic content prescribed for the class in which it is exhibited.
(b) Bottles must not be labelled with business labels. Branded bottles and corks are permissible, but entries in liqueur classes must be made in oval shaped whisky bottles.
(c) Every exhibit must be contained in a bottle clearly marked to show the nature of the exhibit, the year of exhibition, the number of the class in which it is entered and, in the case of liqueurs, the spirit content and the Customs repack number of the liqueur exhibited.
(d) All bottles must be packed in cases or hampers or other suitable containers bearing the name and address of the exhibitor and addressed to the Director, Royal Agricultural Society of New South Wales, Showground, Moore Park, Sydney, and be delivered to the Overseer's Office on the Showground, not later than Friday, 29th January, 1966.
13. In all classes the stock as stated on the certificate of entry may be inspected and checked by a representative of the Society or its nominee. Each exhibitor must supply the Society with a sealed envelope containing the record of any sale made subsequent to their entries being lodged, provided such sale has reduced the stipulated quantity below the minimum except in the case of liqueurs, stocks of which will be accounted for by Customs repack records.
14. An exhibitor may be awarded more than one prize in any one class.
15. The judges may award prizes on the basis of First, Second, Third, Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended, and Commended, but prize money will only be allocated for first and second awards.
16. All persons exhibiting shall accept the decision of the judges appointed by the Society as to the merits of their exhibits.
17. No protest shall be entertained unless made within seven days of the announcement of the awards.
18. No exhibitor shall advertise or allow to be advertised by any means whatsoever and whether by broadcasting, pictorially, or in writing, the fact that any exhibit has won any prize in this section unless such advertisement shows clearly:
(a) Year of award;
(b) Description of Class.
Any competitor making improper use of prizes won in the Section for advertising purposes will be subject to disqualification.
19. All exhibits to become the property of the Society.

INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES.

1. The judges shall have power to disqualify or dismiss, as being not eligible for judging, any exhibit which, in their opinion, does not comply with the regulations in every respect, and such disqualification or dismissal shall be accepted as final. The judges shall have power to call in one or more persons, not being exhibitors, for consultative or advisory purposes.
2. In the event of there being no competition in a class, judges may award a prize or not, as they think fit. Prizes may be withheld in any class where exhibits are considered unworthy.
3. Where, in the opinion of the judge, an exhibit is not in accordance with conditions, he shall, before making the award in the class, refer the matter to the Committee for enquiry.

CHAMPIONSHIP PRIZES.

The Wine and Spirit Merchants' Association of N.S.W., 82 Elizabeth-st., Sydney, has presented Cups or Trophies and replicas or mementoes, one each, to the exhibitor of the best Whisky, Rum, and Gin exhibited in classes as shown hereunder. The Cups or Trophies, before being won outright, must be won on three consecutive occasions by the one exhibitor or five times in all. The Cups or Trophies shall be held by the winner for the year until within one month of the succeeding Royal Easter Show. The name of the winning exhibitor each year will be engraved on the Cup or Trophy. The replica or memento, suitably engraved, will be won outright each year.
